Competition Eligibility

Purpose

To ascertain which members are eligible to compete for the Williamstown Swimming and Lifesaving Club Inc in competition.

Scope

All members who are wishing to compete for the Williamstown Swimming and Lifesaving Club Inc.

Policy

In order to ensure that there is a reciprocal relationship whereby both the Club and the competitor benefit from the privilege of competing for the WS&LSC the club has set obligations that must be met in order to compete for the club.

- Be a current financial member of the club
- Hold the required award for competition
- · Complete the required number of patrol hours
- Have paid the competition levy as decided upon yearly by the Board of Management

These obligations apply to both junior and senior members competing in all competitions including but not limited to:

- Summer Competition
- Australian/Victorian Surf Rowers League
- Pool Competition
- IRB Competition
- Lifesaving Competition

Competitors will be allocated to a patrol and must complete their assigned patrol hours. If unable to attend, it is the competitor's responsibility to arrange a substitution. If the competitor's patrol roster is to change due to substitutions, it is expected that their hours will be obtained over the full 5 months of the patrolling season.

Competitors who fail to meet these requirements may be refused entry to State and Australian Championships.

Any exemptions to this policy may be granted by resolution of the Board of Management.
