Purpose Statement

Water Safety Personnel are responsible as part of a team for the safe conduct and delivery of nipper water activities.

Roles and Responsibilities

The Water Safety Personnel will:

- Report to the Water Safety Supervisor.
- Be aware of the safety and welfare of those involved in the program at all times.
- Immediately report any concerns to the Water Safety Supervisor.
- During nippers must wear a clearly identified uniform, including high visibility rash vest

The Water Safety Personnel requirements are:

- Be a financial member of a lifesaving club.
- Hold a current Working with Children Check that is provided to your club and recorded on your Surfguard profile.
- Completed Child Safe Awareness Course via the LSV training platform.
- Qualified and proficient in SRC or Bronze Medallion
